Review: (2 Samuel 7:1 & 10–11)

[#1] David’s **Faith** is honored in God’s “Hall of Faith” Chapter in the New Testament... Heb. 11
(Heb 11:32-34; 1 Sam. 14:6 & 17:47)

[#2] Twice now, we’ve read these words ... **the LORD preserved David wherever he went ...**
(Psalm 144; Rom 15:4; Phil 2:12-13)

Put on the whole armor of God Ephesians 6:10-18

[#3] While we need to be aware of the spiritual battle, we need not be **scared** because remember Who is faithful to combat Satan’s attacks on our behalf. ... JESUS... (1 John 4:4)

[Truth] “Jesus said to him, “**I am** the way, the **truth**, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” John 14:6

[Righteousness] “For He made Him [**Jesus**] who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him [**Jesus**].” (2 Cor. 5:21)

[Gospel of Peace] Peace I leave with you, **My peace** I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27

[Shield of Faith] “The LORD [JESUS] is ... my **shield**, the power that saves me, and my place of safety. Psalm 18:2 (NLT)

[Helmet of Salvation] “Set your mind on things above [**Jesus**], not on things on the earth.” Col. 3:2

[Sword of the Spirit] God’s Word cuts deep into our hearts and **transforms** us from the inside out...
(2 Cor 3:17-18)

[Praying Always] “So let us **come boldly** to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.” Heb 4:16 (NLT)

[#4] Like David, choose to **officially** demote yourself to second in command? ... Invite Jesus to be King of your life!

2) Read about the spiritual armor in the following passage.

Ephesians 6:14-17 - "[14] Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, [15] and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; [16] above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. [17] And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;"

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3) What do you think it looks like to “put on” each of those pieces of the armor of God? (The first two are done for you as examples)

“Belt of truth”	<i>Rest in God’s truth - trust in it. Recall God’s promises especially in the face of fear/doubt/attack.</i>
“Breastplate of righteousness” -	<i>Stand in Jesus’ righteousness - in His works. We cannot be good enough - but by believing in Jesus, He clothes us in His own righteousness! Isaiah 61:10, 2 Corinthians 5:21</i>
“Boots of the Gospel of Peace” -	
“Shield of Faith” -
