5. That's our **#1-job** as the "Body of Christ!" We won't have **fellowship** with each other; or be an effective **witness** to our loved ones and neighbors without this **unity** Paul speaks of!
6. The toughest pathway to **walk**; the most difficult garment to **put on** is **forgiveness!**

## Food for Thought for the week of July 23, 2023

(Questions and Scriptures for further study)

1) This week Paul deals with the believer's relationship to the world. Certainly, we are "in Christ" and a part of the body; but we are also in the world, where there is temptation. What stands out to you from the following passage?

**Romans 6:12-14** - <sup>12</sup> Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. <sup>13</sup> And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. <sup>14</sup> For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

Pray for the area of your life that is most difficult to give over to the Lord's control.

## Food for Thought for the week of July 23, 2023
